Brief Description of Elders

Elders: Ruling Elders are called to bring spiritual oversight to our church family. While they are elected by the congregation, they represent Christ in all discussions as a Session related to the mission of the church. As Elders their role demands that they be devoted to Scripture and prayer, discerning of God's voice, disciples of the body of Christ and disciplined in their leadership of others. Elders who are biblically qualified for the role are called by God, first, and the congregation, second. We believe that God prepares whom he calls to lead our faith family.
